REASONS FOR DETERMINATION

Legislative Framework

Sub-section 47(6) of the *Parliamentary Business Resources Act 2017* requires the Tribunal to notify its reasons for each determination made in relation to members of parliament to the Minister and to publish those reasons on the Tribunal's website.

What Determination 2018/04 Does

Determination 2018/04 amends Principal Determination 2017/23: Members of Parliament with effect from 1 January 2018.

The Determination updates certain travel allowance provisions for members of parliament, office holders and Ministers of State to continue arrangements that existed in the corresponding provisions of predecessor *Determination 2017/16: Members of Parliament – Travelling Allowance*.

The Tribunal's Reasons

Determination 2017/23: Members of Parliament was signed by the Tribunal on 12 December 2017 to take effect from 1 January 2018. The Determination was part of the suite of legislative instruments implementing the new parliamentary work expenses framework.

This amending determination clarifies the provisions in the new Principal Determination concerning the travel certification process and Canberra travel policy to remove anomalies arising from the simplified drafting process.
