Report on Ministerial Salaries Salary Additional to the Parliamentary Base Salary

STATEMENT

The Tribunal is required to inquire into and report annually on the question of whether any alterations are desirable in the Ministerial salaries that are payable out of public money of the Commonwealth.

The Tribunal does not determine these salaries as, under the Constitution, this is a matter for the Executive Government.

Additional salaries for Ministers are expressed as a percentage of the parliamentary base salary. Eligible parliamentarians receive both the base salary plus the percentage of base salary specified for his or her Ministerial office(s).

The Tribunal has proposed the same percentages in relation to the various offices as set out in the 2017 Report.

This report is made under section 44 of the *Parliamentary Business Resources Act 2017*, which commenced on 1 January 2018.
