REASONS FOR DETERMINATION

Legislative Framework

Sub-section 47(6) of the *Parliamentary Business Resources Act 2017* (the PBR Act) requires the Tribunal to notify its reasons for each determination made in relation to members of Parliament to the Minister and to publish those reasons on the Tribunal's website.

The Tribunal's reason for making this determination is to maintain consistency between the names of parliamentary offices and those referenced in its principal determination, and to provide clarity on the salary determined for those offices.
